INTERSTATE and NATIONAL SWIMMER FUNDRAISING SUPPORT

<u>POLICY</u>

Introduction:

The aim of fundraising support is to enable swimmers that have achieved the relevant qualifying times to take part in any Club approved Interstate Championship and or National Championship event, as an individual or part of a relay team. A \$ amount, decided by the committee will be given to the group, team, or individual prior to the event to support any fundraising activities they as a group, team, or individual choose to arrange. Funds raised from these activities will be awarded as outlined below. (see example)

Fund Raising Committee

The group, team, or individual shall establish a suitably endorsed Fund Raising (sub) Committee to manage the organisation of fundraising activities and disbursement of funds raised from all activities in support of the event.

The Chair of the Fundraising Committee shall be responsible to the PAC Committee for all activities undertaken. Fund Raising activities undertaken will be supported by the club but not organised by the club.

Criteria

The disbursement of funds raised will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. The Event is at State or National Level.
- 2. The member has qualified for the Event as an individual or part of a relay team having achieved the necessary qualifying criteria.
- 3. The member and/or family have contributed to the fundraising activities to support the specific event.
- 4. The member has no outstanding debt to the Club or SwimmingSA

Members may be eligible to receive funds more than once per annum provided the above criteria are met.

Non-Qualifiers

If a cub member has been identified by the coaches as having the potential to qualify for either an Interstate or National event, they or their family will be expected to contribute to the fundraising activities organised for that event. If the member does not qualify, chose not to attend or are unable to attend, their portion of the funds raised will be held in escrow by the Club to be offset against other expenses related to the event ie team transport, coaching costs etc.



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Amount Awarded

The amount awarded to each Swimmer from the fundraising activities will be dependent on.

- 1. The total funds raised by the group, team, or individual in support of the event,
- 2. The number of fund-raising activities each member/and or family has supported for the event.
- 3. Swimmers will only receive a portion of the funds raised at the events which they have supported.

Example

6 swimmers qualify for the event and as a group are awarded \$600.00 club support for fundraising.

activity 1 raises \$660 all 6 attend

activity 2 raises \$1000 only 5 attend

Activity 3 raises \$ 800.00 only 5 attend

Activity 4 raises \$ 600.00 only 4 attend

Total raised \$3060.00 + original \$600 = 3660.00
